



## The Dorothy Groth Sportsmanship Award

The Dorothy Groth Sportsmanship Award is presented to the junior or amateur competitor who best demonstrates the qualities of good sportsmanship throughout the show year. Good sportsmanship is evaluated on how a rider interacts with his/her horse, other competitors, officials, trainers and grooms, regardless of whether he/she wins or loses during competition.

The Sportsmanship Award Committee will review all nominations. The committee will then select the winner of the award based upon the above criteria, **not upon the number of nominations**. The winner will be presented with the Dorothy Groth Sportsmanship Award perpetual trophy at the LAHJA year-end banquet. Each year the award will alternate between a junior and an amateur competitor.
